## **College Application**

The Asheville Community Band Instrumental Music Education Scholarship Application is designed to provide financial help to students pursuing a college degree in instrumental music education. All scholarship funds awarded will be deposited at the school of the recipient's choice, and the awards will be announced each year at the spring concert of the Asheville Community Band.

# **Eligibility Requirements**

- 1. Applicant must be an active registered member of a concert band program.
  - 2. Applicant must have a 90 or higher grade average in band.
- 3. Applicant must show proof of admission to a Music Education program as a full-time college student.
- 4. Applicant must have been actively involved in auditions for district honor band and/or all-state band.
- 5. Applicant must complete the Student Application Form (pages 1 and 2) and proof of admission to a Music Education program and return it to his/her Band Director. Please provide your band director with an envelope and two stamps to cover postage costs
  - 6. The Band Director must submit the completed Student Application, college music program admission and the Band Director's Assessment by April 19, 2024 to the Board of Directors of the Asheville Community Band please respect this date so your student is not disqualified.
